



2. The sanction of the President is also accorded to the release of **Rs 6,90,000/- (Rupees six lakhs ninety thousand only)** to **E.G.S. Pillay Engineering College, Old Nagore Road, Thethi Village, Nagapattinam-611002 (Tamil Nadu)** being the first installment of grant under "Capital Component" for implementation of the above mentioned project. The balance will be released on submission of UC and statement of audited expenditure along with programme completion report.



3. This sanction is subject to the condition that the grantee organization will furnish to the Department of Science & Technology, financial year wise Utilization Certificate (UC) in the proforma prescribed as per GFR 2017 and audited statement of expenditure (SE) along with up to date progress report at the end of each financial year duly reflecting the interest earned / accrued on the grants received under the project. 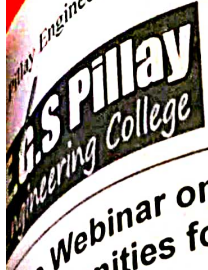
