Professional Core

Accounting for Decision Making

Include the topic International Financial Reporting Standards in the Unit I. In Unit II, it is better to teach Tund flow first and Cash flow next which help the students learn the topic better. In Unit V Overhead costing may be included.

Management Concepts and Organizational Behavior

It is suggested that combining Principles of Management and Organizational Behavior, a new course "Management Concepts and Organizational Behavior" may be introduced.

Statistics for Management

More practice problems shall be given for Unit 3testing Of Hypothesis - Parametric Tests and Unit 4 Non-Parametric Tests

Information Management

It is suggested to include Deep Learning, Big Data, AL, IoT, Crypto Currency, Quantum computing in Unit 5.

Operations Management

It is suggested to include the SimQuick or Gold Sim (process simulation with Excel) in further readings to gain additional information related to Operations management.
